Call for Entries

The Department of HRD and Performance Technologies is pleased to announce our 2015 student competition to be held during the Scholarship Benefit Fashion Show for the Textiles, Apparel, and Merchandising program at Indiana State University. This year's show, Haute Fashion: The Kaleidoscope, will once again include a competition for students and faculty, featuring a Styling element as well as a Design element. We are welcoming all Indiana State students and faculty to submit their work and show us what kind of fashionista they can be!

To facilitate a timely event, we will have a limited amount of entries per category. Each competitor may enter a maximum of 3 pieces to the show; with the exception of *The Collection* category.



Design Competition:

"Emerging Designer" is a freestyle design challenge that will feature garments designed and constructed by students and faculty. Competitors are able to submit an ensemble they have created themselves for judging.

The Design Categories are:

- Chic in the City: Design a garment for strutting around the upscale city of New York.
- Red Carpet Wear: This outfit should be suitable for stepping onto the red carpet for any formal occasion.
- Avant Garde: Create your wild, bold, and risk-taking designs that make a statement.
- Tiny Trend Setters: Create an outfit that is suitable for a child to wear.
- Street Style: Design a unique everyday look for your weekend activities and daily errands.
- Upcycle: Turn trash into sass!
- The Collection: This category will include a line of 5-10 ensembles that will be judged as a whole. None of these garments can be entered as individual items in the other categories, and entrees in this category will not count toward the 3 ensemble limit.

Judges will be looking for things such as:


- Overall look of the outfit, well-groomed model etc.
- Coordinated look with fabric, accessories, and hair & make-up
- Suitable for the age of the model
- Creative techniques enhance garment and make it unique
- Applies basic principles of line, design, color, balance, and style
- Entered in the correct category according to category requirements

Styling Competition:

"Little Black Dress/Suit" is the challenge that we are giving those who think they are up for it! The Little Black Dress is one of the fashion icons of our time, and it has been inspiring the fashion world since it was introduced back in 1926 by Chanel. We are expanding this concept to include a Black Suit to allow male competitors and models.

Competition rules:

Each competitor is to use a "little black dress/suit" and create their own unique style by using other items such as length of dress/pants/sleeves, fabric selection, cut and style, accessories, and jewelry added to the outfit. We envision that most competitors will start with a purchased dress/suit, but competitors are permitted to construct the original garment as well. Our challenge to you is to make this dress your own.

Judges will be looking for things such as:

- Outfit applies basic principles of line, design, and style
- Appropriate jewelry and accessories chosen
- Fabric style and accessories match
- Suitable and appropriate for the model wearing the outfit
- Hair and Make-up compliment the outfit
- Outfit overall is clean, pressed, and presented well

Models:

For the ease of designing/styling purposes, each designer/stylist is encouraged to find their own model. If a designer/stylist cannot find their own model, we will be holding a casting call for models. The casting calls will be held on September 15th and 16th. If you do need a model provided, after the casting call is conducted we will pair a designer/stylist up with models.
